5.30 – 7.00	Old Red Lion 42 Kennington Park Rd SE11 4RS <i>(Antic Pub Co)</i>	4 rotating beers – we saw Revolution (!) New Gold Dream and Red Right Hand, Volden Pale Ale and Trumans Black	Food from 5-8pm. Grade 2 listed oak beamed pub with 3 bars and outdoor section. Quaint old decor including dolls houses. Good place to lose your wallet..... Kennington tube very near.
7.10 – 8.00	Oaka at The Mansion House 48 Kennington Park Rd SE11 4RS <i>(Oakham Ales)</i>	Only Oakham Ales pub in London – Car Thief, Citra, JHB, Bishops Farewell and Green Devil	Large L-shaped bar. Food from 5.30pm specialising in Asian – Thai, Malaysian and Vietnamese. Unsurprisingly Kennington tube also very near.
8.10 – 9.00	The Tommyfield 185 Kennington Lane SE11 4EZ <i>(Three Cheers Pub Co)</i>	Taylor Landlord, Sambrooks Junction	Spacious pub with plenty of standing room and seating areas. Long bar at far end. Food 6-10.30pm. Wine rack handy for exit! Local Tommyfield Market was home to Britain’s first Fish and Chip shop.
9.10 – 10.00	The Pilgrim 247 Kennington Lane SE11 5QU <i>(Whiskey Whiskey Tango Pubs)</i>	2 rotating beers – we saw Pilgrim Brewery’s Progress, Caledonian Flying Scotsman	Open space corner pub with plenty of comfy seating. Friendly Southern Hemisphere bar manager might explain how the game works in the Gents!!
10.10 – End	Riverside Hamilton House 5 St George’s Wharf SW8 2LE <i>(Young’s)</i>	Wells Bombardier, Young’s Bitter, London Gold and Special	Large modern Youngs’ restaurant pub. Food all day. Riverside views from outside terrace. Plenty of seating. Handy for Vauxhall tube but advised to use underpass to access.
